PUBLIC NOTICE IS HEREBY GIVEN that the City of Calimesa as CITY, invites sealed bids for the above-stated project and will receive such bids in the offices of the City Clerk, 908 Park Avenue, Calimesa, California 92320, up to the hour of **10:00 a.m., Tuesday, December 4, 2018**, at which time they will be publicly opened and read in the Norton Younglove Multipurpose Senior Center.

This is a Federal Aid Project subject to the Required Contract Provisions of FHWA Form 1273 required to be physically incorporated into each contract, subcontract and subsequent lower-tier subcontracts.

Bidders are advised that, as required by Federal Law, the City of Calimesa is implementing new Disadvantaged Enterprise requirements for Disadvantaged Business Enterprises (DBE). The DBE Contractor Goal is 6.0% for this project. Commit to achievement of DBE contract goals, Exhibit 15-G (Section L Page E-58 and E-59) and/or demonstration of Good Faith Efforts, Exhibit 15-H (Section L Page E-60 to E-62) to do so.

All work must be completed within **20 (twenty)** working days after the date of authorization specified in the Notice to Proceed and to diligently prosecute said work, including corrective items of work, day to day thereafter, except as adjusted by subsequent Contract Change Orders.

Paper copies of the contract documents (plans and specifications) may be obtained at Calimesa City Hall, 908 Park, Calimesa, California, 92320, telephone (909) 795-9801, upon payment of a \$15.00 nonrefundable fee, if picked up, or payment of a \$20.00 nonrefundable fee, if requested by mail. Digital plans and specifications may be obtained from the City at no cost by emailing a request to: laskew@cityofcalimesa.net. Prospective bidders shall either purchase or obtain digital plans and specifications from the City so as to be included on a bidder's list in the event addenda are issued. If plans and specifications are obtained from bid rooms or other sources, it is the bidder's responsibility to obtain any and all addenda issued, and the City will not be held responsible for missing addenda. The successful Bidder shall perform, with its own organization, Contract work amounting to at least thirty percent of (30%) of the Contract bid items. However, any designated "Specialty Items" may be performed by subcontract and the amount of any such "Specialty Items" may be deducted from the Contract items before computing the amount of work required to be performed by the Contractor.

Pursuant to Section 1773 of the Labor Code, the State prevailing wage rates for this contract will be determined by the Director of the California Department of Industrial

Relations (DIR) and are online at <http://www.dir.ca.gov/DLSR/PWD> but not printed in the Specifications. In addition, the bidder's attention is directed to the provisions of Section 1777.5 (Chapter 1411, Statutes of 1968) and 1777.5 of the Labor Code concerning the employment of apprentices by the Contractor or any such subcontractor under him.

This contract is subject to state contract nondiscrimination and compliance requirements pursuant to Government Code Section 12990. The CITY hereby affirmatively ensures that minority business enterprises will be afforded full opportunity to submit bids in response to this notice and will not be discriminated against on the basis of race, color, national origin, ancestry, sex, or religion in any consideration leading to the award of contract.

For any conflict of Interest in the procurement of supplies, equipment, construction, and services by sub-recipients, the conflict of interest provisions in 24 CFR 85.36, OMB Circular A-110, and 24 CFR 570.611 shall apply. No employee, officer, or agent of the sub-recipient shall participate in the selection, award, or administration of a contract if a conflict of interest, real or apparent, would involve.

Bids must be prepared on the approved Proposal forms in conformance with the Instructions to Bidders and submitted in a sealed envelope plainly marked on the outside. The bid must be accompanied by certified or cashier's check, or bidder's bond, made payable to the CITY for an amount no less than 10 percent of the amount bid, and all Federal Forms included in this bid package must be filled out and submitted with bid proposal in order for bid to be considered.

The successful bidder shall be licensed in accordance with provisions of the Business and Professions Code and shall possess a State Contractor's License, Class A, at the time this contract is awarded. The successful Contractor and his subcontractors will be required to possess business licenses from the City of Calimesa and register as required by SB-854 with the Department of Industrial Relations as a Contractor or Subcontractor involved with Public Works Projects.

The CITY reserves the right to reject any or all bids, to waive any irregularity, and to take all bids under advisement for a period of 60 days.
