

ORDINANCE NO. 90-2

AN ORDINANCE OF THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF CALIMESA, CALIFORNIA, SETTING THE DATE, TIME AND LOCATION OF CITY COUNCIL MEETINGS AND OTHER OPERATING PROCEDURES AND DECLARING THE URGENCY THEREOF

THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF CALIMESA DOES ORDAIN AS FOLLOWS:

Section 1. The City Council of the City of Calimesa finds that there is a need to adopt operating procedures.

Section 2. Election and Tenure.

The electors of the City of Calimesa shall elect Councilmembers at the general municipal election held every two years on the date of the statewide general election.

Section 3. Presiding Officer.

(a) The City Council shall meet after the general municipal election and choose one of its members as Mayor and one of its members as Mayor Pro Tempore. (Gov. Code, § 36801.)

(b) In addition to the powers and duties of a Councilmember, the Mayor, or in the Mayor's absence, the Mayor Pro Tempore, shall be the presiding officer of the City Council. (Gov. Code, § 36802.)

Section 4. Compensation.

(a) Each Councilmember shall be entitled to a salary in the amount of \$300.00 per month. (Gov. Code, § 36516.)

(b) Upon submission of an itemized account, any Councilmember may be reimbursed for the actual and necessary expenses incurred in the performance of official duties. (Gov. Code, § 36514.5.)

Section 5. Meetings.

(a) Regular meetings of the City Council shall be held on the second and fourth Monday of each month. Regular meetings shall commence at 7:00 p.m.. Regular meetings shall be conducted at the Norton Younglove Multipurpose Senior Center, 908 Park Avenue, Calimesa, California 92320. If a regular meeting falls on a holiday, the

regular meeting shall be held on the next business day. (Gov. Code, § 36808.)

Section 6. Rules of Procedure.

The City Council may, from time to time, adopt by resolution, rules of procedure for the conduct of meetings. These resolutions shall be compiled and maintained by the City Clerk and made available to the public and to the City Council during every meeting. (Gov. Code, § 36813.)

Section 7. Orderly Conduct.

(a) All persons shall comply with the meeting procedures announced by resolution of the City Council and no person shall interfere with or interrupt a City Council meeting.

(b) The presiding officer may appoint a member of the Riverside County Sheriff's Department as Sergeant at Arms, who shall carry out the directions of the presiding officer including making arrests as directed by the presiding officer. Any person who fails to comply with a direction given by the presiding officer may be removed.


Section 8. Urgency.

The City of Calimesa has, on this date, become incorporated and there are no local laws or ordinances to guide the operation of the City in its task of protecting the public peace, health and safety of its citizens. The City Council finds and determines, therefore, that the adoption of this Ordinance as an Urgency Ordinance is necessary for the immediate preservation of the public peace, health and safety.

Section 9. Effective Date.






