Per Section 12.9.05(F)(1), The following standards must be followed (please initial):

_____ No political shall be placed earlier than forty-five (45) days prior to the election for which it addresses and shall be removed no later than three (3) days following the date of election.

_____ A political sign located in a commercial/industrial zone shall not exceed thirty-two (32) square feet in total area for one side. No sign shall be placed in a manner that would obstruct visibility of traffic.

_____ A political sign located in a residential zone shall not exceed eight (8) square feet in total are for one side. No sign shall be placed in a manner that would obstruct visibility of traffic.

_____ No political sign shall exceed an overall height of eight (8) feet. Signs used for identification of political headquarters shall comply with the provisions of Title 12, Chapter 9 of the Calimesa Municipal code.

_____ No political signs shall be posted on any public property or in the public right of way.

_____ If the Director of Planning finds that any political sign has been posted of is being maintained on public property or in the public right-of-way in violation of the above conditions, the owner of the sign shall be given written notice to remove said sign. Said notice shall include a brief statement of the reasons for requiring approval. If the person so notified fails to correct the violation to remove the sign within five (5) business days after such notice, the Director of Planning may cause said sign to be removed. If the owner of the sign cannot in good faith be located within a reasonable time, the sigh shall be deemed abandoned. Any political sign that remains posted for more than fourteen (14) days after the elections to which it pertains shall also be deemed abandoned. The Director of Planning may cause such abandoned signs and any signs which constitute an immediate peril to persons or property to be removed summarily and without prior notice.
