Good News for the Calimesa Pet Owner: A Shorter Drive to the Shelter

Animal Services Director Robert Miller announced that the Banning Shelter will be home to Calimesa's lost pets and strays.

The city of Calimesa initiated a contract with the Riverside County Department of Animal Services in the mid-1990s and lost pets were taken to the Ramona Humane Society in San Jacinto.

But, starting June 1, Animal Services becomes the new operator of the Banning Shelter.

Now anytime Animal Services officers recover a lost pet or a stray, the animals will be transported in the air-conditioned fleet trucks to the Banning Shelter.

The Banning Shelter is located at 2242 E. Charles Street in Banning.

The hours of operation, beginning June 1, are: Tuesdays through Friday 11 a.m. to 6 p.m.

Saturday hours are 11 a.m. to 5 p.m.
